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5. Student Life at Sungshin

Health Insurance	Private Health Insurance (Mandatory) - As required by the Korean Ministry of Education, you are required to be covered by Korean private health insurance. - For a one-time payment of around KRW 80,000, coverage is provided for six months (one semester). - The purpose of this private insurance is to cover medical gaps that may arise from the time you enter the country until your National Health Insurance coverage begins, which can take several months. <u>The Certificate of Admission will be issued only after the payment has been confirmed.</u> Further details will be provided to students who have completed the application.
	National Health Insurance (Mandatory) - National Health Insurance is mandated by the law. - National Health Insurance is applied upon the issuance of the Residence Card. - Details about registration and fees are TBA. - Fees must be paid on a monthly basis. (₩80,000–100,000 per month) - Students with Japanese or French nationality are eligible to apply for the exemption. (Students must apply for the exemption individually)
Student Visa (D-2)	All incoming international students at Sungshin must obtain a D-2 student visa. Required documents provided by Sungshin Women's University: - Certificate of Admission - Business Registration Certificate of Sungshin Women's University Documents Sending Date: - Spring semester: End of December - Fall semester: End of June ◆ Note - After receiving the Certificate of Admission and the Business Registration Certificate from us via email, you can apply for a D-2 student visa at the Korean Embassy in your home country. Please contact the relevant diplomatic mission for specific procedures, required forms, and processing time, as they may vary by country. - The D-2 student visa is valid for a single entry to Korea. <u>Without an ARC, you cannot re-enter Korea on the same student visa.</u> Be sure to obtain your ARC before departure during your exchange period. - Please note that your D-2 visa will be used upon your first entry into Korea and will be invalidated when you depart from Korea in the absence of a valid Registration Card. Should you wish to go ahead with the above planned itinerary, you will need to apply for D-2 visa again for your exchange program.
Housing	Dormitory Accommodation: Dormitory housing is available for international students. Room Type: Double Room / Triple Room / Quadruple Room (Room assignments may vary depending on the university's circumstances.)
