This exhibition traces the creative journey of Keum Ki-sook, who has spent over 40 years bridging fashion and fine art, tradition and modernity, to forge her own distinctive domain known as "fashion art." Works crafted from unconventional materials — wire, beads, organza, and repurposed waste — span from single garments to large-scale spatial installations, exploring themes of artistic expansion, coexistence, and enlightenment in a wide variety of forms.

감사의 정원(garden of gratitude)

Located in Gwanghwamun Plaza, this newly opened memorial space honors the 23 nations (including South Korea) that fought in the Korean War. It features **23 stone pillars, each standing 6.25 meters tall**, shaped to resemble soldiers holding rifles at present-arms ("받들어총"). Below the monument lies **Freedom Hall**, an underground media exhibition space showcasing Korea's history and growth.
