Preparation for graduate school and application qualifications

- 4 semesters for Master's degree, 4 semesters for PhD degree
 6 semesters for Integrated master's and PhD degree
- Students in the doctoral program and Integrated master's and PhD degree must register for research twice (2 semesters) after completion (500,000 won per semester).

Preparation for graduate school and application qualifications

- Eligibility for application
- 1. Current students and students on leave of absence who have completed 5 semesters of undergraduate studies (including transfer students)
- 2. Applicants with a total GPA of 3.30 or higher up to the semester of application
- 3. A person recommended by the head of his or her department (department)
- 4. Graduate school application departments (majors) are limited to departments (majors) related to the main major, double major, linked major, and minor in the undergraduate program, and multiple applications are not permitted.
- Selection
- 1. Selection method and selection period

 Document screening and interview: Document screening is a comprehensive review and evaluation of criteria set by the department (major) based on letters of recommendation, undergraduate transcripts, and research plans.

 Selection period: Conducted in July of each academic year

2. Course registration and credit recognition for selected students
Those selected for the combined bachelor's and master's degree
program must take both undergraduate and graduate credits and
can register for up to 3 additional credits each semester.

Those selected for the combined bachelor's and master's degree program must be assigned an advisor at the beginning of the semester (6th semester) in which they are selected.

You must complete at least 6 credits of graduate school major courses under the guidance of your advisor until you graduate from undergraduate school, and you can complete up to 12 credits.

Master's degree course subjects completed by those selected for the combined bachelor's and master's degree course are not recognized as undergraduate course credits, but are recognized as master's degree course credits after admission to graduate school.

The grades of master's degree course courses completed by those selected for the combined bachelor's and master's degree course are recorded on the transcript and "(Graduate School)" is written next to the name of the course taken.

O Undergraduate graduation requirements

Must meet basic requirements for graduation from undergraduate program

Must complete at least 6 credits of graduate school major courses before graduating from undergraduate school.

Upon graduation from undergraduate school, the total grade point average of credits earned must be 3.30 or higher.

Those who meet the undergraduate graduation requirements must submit an application for graduate school admission to the graduate school within the application period in the first semester (7th semester) of the fourth year.

O Cancellation of midterm waiver
In the following cases, your eligibility to complete a combined bachelor's and master's degree course will be canceled, and you must register for courses with a minimum number of credits in the second semester (8th semester) of your 4th year. Additionally, those who drop out cannot graduate early even if they meet the early graduation requirements (overall GPA of 4.20 and completion of all courses).

- -Those who have given up on a combined bachelor's and master's degree program before enrolling in graduate school
- Those who do not meet the undergraduate program graduation requirements
- Those who have not completed more than 6 credits of graduate school major courses
- Those who did not register during the graduate school new student registration period
- Applicants with a total grade point average of less than 3.30 upon graduation from undergraduate school
- Matters related to graduate school admission
- 1. Graduate school admission and academic records processing
- ① Graduate school admission
- Those who graduate from an undergraduate degree in a combined bachelor's and master's degree program are admitted to the graduate school's master's program through a special selection process.
- Those who graduate from an undergraduate degree in a combined bachelor's and master's degree program must register according to the graduate school's registration notice at the same time as undergraduate graduation. If you do not register, your undergraduate graduation will be cancelled.
- Details of graduate school courses are based on the graduate school regulations of the year of admission.
- 2) Whether leave of absence or withdrawal is permitted
- Leave of absence or withdrawal is not permitted during the first semester after admission to graduate school.
- Submit a pledge upon admission to graduate school

- 2. Benefits for those who have completed a combined bachelor's and master's degree program
- Graduate Nanhyang Scholarship: Full reduction of graduate school admission fee
- Upon graduation from undergraduate school, you may be exempted from completing the graduation thesis (practical test, exam) required by the department. However, double (interconnected) majors may only be exempted from completing the graduation thesis (practical test, exam) corresponding to the major of the selected graduate school department.
- You can apply for special selection when entering graduate school.
- When allocating various scholarships to the department, priority is given to those who meet the qualification requirements.
