Within psychology, there are basic research fields such as personality psychology, social psychology, physiological psychology, learning psychology, developmental psychology, experimental psychology, cognitive psychology, and quantitative psychology, and applied fields such as clinical psychology, counseling psychology, and industrial and organizational psychology.

Psychology is a fundamental discipline in the social sciences and humanities, and an understanding of psychology is essential for other fields that deal with human beings, such as law, management, and medicine. If you major in psychology as an undergraduate, you can use your knowledge of psychology in your work and in your relationships.
