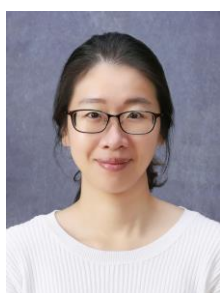

Track Description	<p>Track for cultivating teaching professionalism emphasizes the development of expertise in subject-specific knowledge, instructional design and implementation, student guidance and counseling, communication skills, as well as promoting ethical character and effective teaching methods.</p> <p>It aims to equip individuals with the qualities necessary for educational guidance, life coaching, and classroom management, fostering an understanding of learners and practical field experience.</p> <p>Teacher Certification Requirements</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Required Credits for Teacher Certification           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Major: Foundational Education Courses(21 credits) + Subject Area Education Courses(8 credits) including required courses, for a total of 50 credits</li> <li>- Teacher Training Subject: Theoretical foundations of teaching (12 credits) + Pedagogical electives (6 credits) + Teaching practicum (4 credits) for a total of 22 credits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>※ Grade Criteria: Average grade of 75/100 or higher for major and double major subjects, and 80/100 or higher for pedagogical courses.</li> <li>Teaching Aptitude and Personality Assessment: to be successfully passed at least twice.</li> <li>First Aid and CPR Training: Training to be completed at least twice.</li> <li>Accumulation of a total of 130 or more credits, including liberal arts, major, and elective courses, to meet graduation requirements. Meeting all criteria is necessary for obtaining teacher certification.</li> <li>Requirements for a second teaching major are the same as for the primary teaching major, meeting all criteria for teacher certification (basic requirements, subject-specific education, total credits, and grade criteria).</li> </ol> <p>※ Admission to the teaching program is based on academic performance up to the point of selection, and selection is determined by grade point average in the major department with available slots within the teaching quota.</p>
